Africa's Development Dynamics 2023: Investing in Sustainable Development

Increasing sustainable investment is critical to achieving the African Union's Agenda 2063. Despite large opportunities, investment flows – from within and outside Africa – remain insufficient to accelerate the transformation of economies and the creation of decent jobs. Better information on those opportunities, better policies and stronger capacity in African institutions are necessary to reduce risk perceptions and increase the financing of investment.

The <u>Africa's Development Dynamics 2023</u> report investigates how the African continent can mobilise more sustainable investments. The report aims to assist African leaders and civil society in reaching the targets of the African Union's Agenda 2063 at all levels: continental, regional, national, and local. It benefits from support by the European Union, the German Ministry of Development Cooperation (BMZ) and its technical agency GIZ, the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of Portugal and the Camões Institute, the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of Italy, the African Capacity Building Foundation (ACBF), and the African Union Development Agency (AUDA-NEPAD).
