Our 200-hectare innovation precinct is home to:

- 16,000+ staff, including 1,000 researchers
- 20,000 students
- 2,500 residents
- 50+ start-ups and SMEs in health, life sciences and technology
- 100+ active clinical trials

Backed by a partnership between the City of Gold Coast, Griffith University, Gold Coast Health and the Queensland Government, the precinct is supported by more than \$5 billion in health, education, research, transport and residential infrastructure.

Explore The Brisbane-Gold Coast Biomedical Corridor

Pre-conference tours (Tuesday 20 October, TBC) will showcase three of Queensland's leading biomedical innovation precincts. Together, these interconnected hubs form one of Australia's most significant life sciences and health innovation corridors, linking world-class hospitals, research institutes, start-ups and industry partners across South East Queensland.

Herston Health Precinct (Brisbane)

Home to Australia's largest hospital, the Queensland Children's Hospital, and leading research institutes including QIMR Berghofer, Herston sits adjacent to the future main stadium for the Brisbane 2032 Olympic and Paralympic Games.

Boggo Road Innovation Junction (Brisbane)

Anchored by the Princess Alexandra Hospital and the Translational Research Institute, BRIJ is also home to the ENTRI facility, opening in 2026 to support accessible biomedical manufacturing for emerging biotech, pharma and medtech companies.

Gold Coast Health and Knowledge Precinct (Gold Coast)

Explore the Griffith Institute for Biomedicine and Glycomics (IBG), home to 400+ researchers, alongside the Griffith Clinical Trial Unit, Cohort Innovation Space, the BioSpine neurorehabilitation lab and the new AUD \$154M RDX building.
